Flights to Auckland good for Kapiti

The Kapiti Chamber of Commerce welcomes today's news from Air Nelson about weekday Air New Zealand flights to Auckland commencing in October.

"To all the other things which make Kapiti a great place to live and do business, we will soon be able to add having our own Air New Zealand serviced airport" says Chamber Chairman Mark Ternent. "This is a major step forward for Kapiti – and will put us on a lot of maps we weren't on before."

Daily flights to Auckland will give better work and leisure travel options for people living in Kapiti, and from Tawa to Levin. Business travellers won't have to get up quite as early and face the traffic. Friends and relatives will find it easier to visit people on the Coast, while Kapiti Coasters will have easier access not just to Auckland, but also to all the airports served from Auckland.
